NATIVE AMERICANS AND ALASKAN NATIVES HAVE A NEW WAY TO GET MEDICAID HEALTH CARE



If you are a federally-recognized tribal member or individual eligible for services through Indian Health Service (IHS), you have choices for how you receive Medicaid services. You may choose to enroll in a health plan, including the EBCI Tribal Option, or stay in NC Medicaid Direct. You will be able to make the best choice for you and your family. You can change your health plan at any time.

YOUR CHOICES

- The EBCI Tribal Option is a health plan managed by the Cherokee Indian Hospital Authority (CIHA). The EBCI Tribal Option addresses the unique health and medical needs of American Indian/Alaskan Native Medicaid beneficiaries. All behavioral health services that are covered by NC Medicaid Direct are also covered by the EBCI Tribal Option.
- A health plan is a group of doctors, hospitals and other providers. They work together to give you
 the health care you need. Everything physical health, behavioral health and medicine will come
 from the same health plan.
- NC Medicaid Direct is North Carolina's current health care program for Medicaid members. This is how you receive your Medicaid services now.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO

1 Choose a primary care provider (PCP)

Health plans work with different PCPs. To keep your doctor, clinic or other health care provider as your PCP, find out which health plan they work with. You can also choose a new PCP. For a list of providers for each health plan, go to ncmedicaidplans.gov, use the NC Medicaid Managed Care mobile app or call us toll free at **1-833-870-5500** (TTY: 1-833-870-5588). If you do not choose a PCP, your health plan will choose one for you.
